



Joining them are the **Quiet Corner Fiddlers** whose monthly open sessions draw from the New England, Irish, Finnish, Cajun, and Klezmer traditions. On July 10, they'll bring their reels, jigs, waltzes, hornpipes, strathpeys, rags, foxtrots, polkas, and hoedowns to Manchester's East Side.

The **Veterans Art Foundation** closes out the 2016 Sundays at 4 Summer Series on the National Day of Service and Remembrance. The Veterans Art Foundation was created by veterans for veterans, with the understanding that the arts can be used to cope with the traumas of war. In 2009, after returning home from his tour of duty, Iraq war veteran Michael Hawley found expressing himself through film and photography helped him cope with his trauma. He established the Veterans Art Foundation (VAF) with the goal of assisting other veterans who were going through a similar experience. The mission of VAF is to prove programs and services that allow veterans to heal through the arts. Whether it is through film, music, writing, photography, or painting, the VAF is committed to helping veterans readjust to civilian life.
