The Great Resignation


According to the US Bureau of Labor Statistics:

- **2021** 47.8 million Americans quit their jobs
- 2022 50.5 million Americans quit their jobs
- Underlying Forces Workers are:
- *Retiring* in greater numbers but are not *relocating* in large numbers;
- *Reconsidering* work-life balance and care roles;
- *Reshuffling* or making localized switches among industries rather than exiting the labor market entirely; and,
- *Reluctance* to return to in-person jobs. (Harvard Business Review)

Changing Workplace

- 52% of local government employees are considering leaving their jobs (Jan 2022)
- While other sectors are experiencing high quit rates, **only** the government and the leisure sectors are now seeing actual declines in workers
- Rates of burnout in workers across most U.S. job fields are 40% to 50% (Business Insider)
- According to the National Employee Survey (NES)
 - 84% feel positive about working for local government
 - 86% say their values align with their work
- Legislation to reduce hours considered in Maryland, New York, and California (February 2023)
- 4 Day Week Global (4WDG) Study
