Notice of Public Hearing for CDBG Program Year 48
(October 1, 2022 – September 30, 2023)

The Town of Manchester is beginning to prepare its CDBG Program Year 48 Annual Action Plan. Residents and community organizations are invited to provide comments and suggestions on the use of CDBG funding during the October 1, 2022 – September 30, 2023 program year. The Town has not been notified of the grant amount, but it is expected to be similar to the current allocation of \$573,392. Examples of activities eligible for funding include public service programs, housing rehabilitation and public facilities improvements.

Virtual public hearings will be held Thursday, February 24th at 11am and 5pm. Persons who wish to attend must submit a request to hguerette@manchesterct.gov. Only those who submit a request will receive a link to join the Zoom meeting. Comments can also be sent in writing to the same email address.

CDBG funds can support a broad range of community projects and activities, provided they meet one or more of the following national objectives: (i) benefit low- and moderate-income persons; or (ii) aid in the prevention and elimination of slum or blight; or (iii) meet other community development needs of a particular urgency and for which other funding sources are not available.
