- * Program year: October 1 September 30
- * Describes projects funded during the program year
- Provides goals and outlines how funds will be spent
- Identifies funding sub-recipients



ANNUAL ACTION PLAN, CONTINUED

- 2023-2024 grant = \$533,876
 - * Approximately 2% increase
 - Propose reprogramming \$44,575.25
- National Objectives:
 - 1. Benefit low/moderate income persons
 - 2. Prevent/eliminate slum or blight; or
 - 3. Meet urgent community development need




CURRENT HOUSING PROGRAMS

- Lead paint hazards and property maintenance code issues
- * Emergency replacement program: Available town-wide to eligible households

REBUILDING TOGETHER

 Roof replacements on income-qualified, owneroccupied homes

- * 15% spending cap
- * Types of projects:
 - * Job training
 - * Homeless outreach
