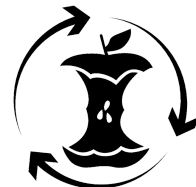

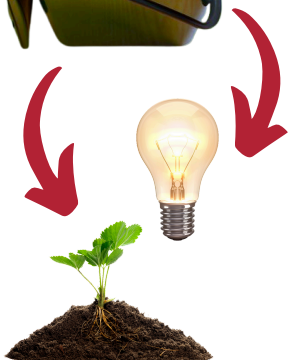

Register for a FREE Recycling Permit and check the appropriate box to participate.* Participants will receive a FREE 6-gallon food scrap pail at the Sanitation Office! Already a current permit holder? Call or stop by the Sanitation Office to sign-up!

Separate out your food scraps by following the instructions on the back of this sheet. BPI Certified compostable bags and brown paper bags are okay to use. DO NOT use plastic bags.

Bring your food scraps to the transfer station where they will be collected and transported to a local facility for composting. The bio-gas that's created in the process will be captured for energy!



All Manchester residents are eligible to drop-off their food scraps at the Transfer Station!

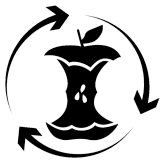

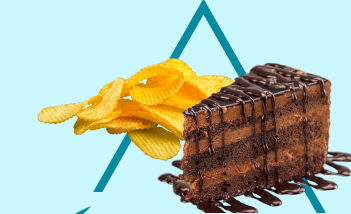
