

Is Your Used Crib Safe?



Before you put your baby to sleep in a used crib, check to be sure it's safe. A safe crib has –

- ♥ A firm, tight-fitting mattress
- ♥ No loose, missing, or broken hardware or slats
- ♥ No more than 2 3/8" between slats (about the width of a soda can).
- ♥ No corner posts over 1/16" high
- ♥ No cutout designs in the headboard or footboard
- ♥ Make sure any paint is lead free

If your used crib isn't safe, don't use it.

DESTROY IT.
