

MANCHESTER DIAL-A-RIDE

- <u>Service animals on board the vehicle</u>
 - *"Personal aides and service animals are allowed to accompany riders, if needed."*
 - The Dial-a-Ride welcome packet that all new riders receive states that service animals are allowed to travel on Dial-a-Ride buses with their rider.
 - New riders are asked, at time of intake, if they travel with a service animal.
- Passengers traveling with respirators or portable oxygen
 - Passengers are allowed to bring portable O2 tanks and/or respirators on Dial-a-Ride buses.
 - The Dial-a-Ride welcome packet that all new riders receive states that medical devices are allowed on Dial-a-Ride buses.
 - New riders are asked, at time of intake, if they travel with a medical device or other medical equipment.
- <u>Passengers without a mobility device that wish to use the lift to board the vehicle.</u>
 - Passengers are able to use the wheelchair lift with or without a mobility device.
 Passengers requiring the use of the wheelchair lift are assisted by the driver to ensure they are securely fastened while the lift is in operation.
- Passenger boarding time
 - There is no time limit or restriction for passenger boarding time.
